Registration / Bus Changes Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

On Monday and Tuesday, August 29th and 30th, the Central Community School System will be registering new students and changing bus routes for students affected by the flood. Below are a series of questions that parents may have in regards to these changes as they prepare to send their child back to school on Tuesday, September 6th.

1. I am a current student in the Central Community School System. My house was flooded. I am living in a temporary location *within* the Central Community School District. Can I change my bus route to my temporary location?
 - Yes. Please come to the Central Intermediate library on Monday or Tuesday (August 29th & 30th) between the hours of 8:00AM – 4:30PM. You will be able to complete a bus route change request at this time.
2. I am a current student in the Central Community School System. My house was flooded. I am living in a temporary location that is *not* within the Central Community School District. Can I continue attending Central schools and what do I do about transportation?
 - Yes, you can continue attending your school within the Central Community School System. We can only provide bus transportation *within* the Central Community School District. You will have to provide your own transportation to and from school if you are temporarily housed outside of the Central Community School District. There is no need to complete a bus change request form.
3. I am a current student in the Central Community School System. My house was flooded. I do not ride the school bus. How do I inform my school of my temporary location?
 - On the first day that students return to school (Tuesday, September 6th), a new color-coded “emergency card” will be sent home with each student. Parents are asked to complete the form so that each school will have a record of where students are currently residing.
4. I am not a currently enrolled student in the Central Community School System. I have been displaced from my permanent home and am now living with someone in the Central Community School District. Can I attend the Central Community School System?
 - Yes, you will be able to attend the Central Community School System. Please come to Central Middle School on Monday or Tuesday (August 29th & 30th) between the hours of 8:00AM – 4:30PM. You will complete registration at this time. Please note: if you are living with a current resident of Central, they must accompany you to register. The person that you are residing with, must show proof of residency (i.e. ownership of property or lease, utility bills, etc). Please bring any student documents that you have available (i.e. grades, birth certificate, social security card, etc).
5. I am not a currently enrolled student in the Central Community School System. I have been displaced from my permanent home, but am not currently residing in the Central Community School District. Can I attend the Central Community School System?
 - No, you will not be able to attend the Central Community School System. In order to attend the CCSS, you must be currently living in the district (either temporarily or permanently).
6. I am not a currently enrolled student in the Central Community School System. I have just moved to the area and need to register. What should I do?
 - You can register at Central Middle School on Monday or Tuesday (August 29th & 30th) between the hours of 8:00AM – 4:30PM. For further information on required documentation, please visit our website [here](#).
