

1. Does the District have a CMS or technology preference (i.e. open source CMS, .NET, etc.)?

 - a. Will the District provide translated site content? Or is the District seeking an automated translation tool like Google Translate? The District will provide some of the translated content. Google Translate is an alternative as it allows the viewer to choose the desired language.
5. The RFP mentions an employee only web portal, can you provide details on the functionality staff will have access to upon logging into the portal? The employee only portal is a feature that the District would like to have the ability to use in the future or if necessary. The ability to “lock” information for only selected staff to view and edit for future use is not being used at the current time. The vision behind this option would be to allow the editor to insert content for a selected “shared” audience before it is viewed by the public so that the collaborators can view and make edits before it is published. The District would like to have this feature in case it is needed.
 - a. Will all staff have access to the same content? Or will content access be specific to the staff member or staff member’s role? It would be specific to the staff member and the selected group.
