



## State Placement Test for incoming 5th and 9th graders

According to the Louisiana Department of Education, students seeking to transfer to a public school in grades 5 or 9 from any

- in-state nonpublic school,
- approved home study program, or
- out-of-state school,

shall be required to take the English language arts and mathematics portions of the state placement test to inform placement decisions and any supports needed to assist struggling students.

Central Community School System offers this test for free to incoming fifth and ninth graders from in-state nonpublic schools, approved home study programs, or out-of-state schools.
